This TCS product is a professional quality Turf and Ornamental fertilizer. Its suitability for use in any given application depends on existing soil chemistry, turf/plant type, and intended use of the area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Turf): The best results with this product are obtained when it is applied to actively growing grass, and watered into the turf soon after application. Avoid mowing immediately following application to prevent pick-up. Application with rotary or pendulum spreaders is recommended for uniform distribution. The use of a drop spreader is not recommended. Consult your spreader manual or spreader manufacturer to determine spreader settings to achieve application rates desired. You may need to adjust the setting depending on the walking speed, spreader condition, and product.

This fertilizer contains phosphorus and may not be used on turf in the state of Maryland except when 1) Providing nutrients to a specific soils and target vegetation as determined to be necessary in accordance with a soil test that was conducted by a laboratory identified under section 8-803.7 of the Agriculture Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, performed no more than 3 years before the application; 2) Establishing vegetation for the first time, such as after land disturbance, provided the application is conducted in accordance with the recommended application rates established by the State; or 3) Reestablishing or repairing a turf area. Per Virginia applications, this lawn fertilizer contains phosphorous and is intended only for nonagricultural use on (i) turf during its first growing season, (ii) on turf areas being repaired or renovated, and (iii) on turf where a soil test performed within the last 3 years indicates a phosphorous deficiency. This fertilizer is not intended for the routine maintenance of turf.

> In the state of MD, NH, NJ, and VA DO NOT exceed 0.67 LBS. of Nitrogen per 1,000 SQ FT. In the state of MD, do not exceed the annual limit of 2 LBS. of Phosphorus per 1,000 SQ. FT.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Ornamentals): For new landscape plantings, evenly apply up to 0.8 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. depending on crop and soil analysis. Work into the soil to a depth of 6 inches. Once plants are established apply additional fertilizer based on County Extension Service recommendations. Apply fertilizer evenly and do not apply fertilizer directly to plant foliage or stems. Water in after application. For shrubs, spread fertilizer evenly at a rate of up to 0.8 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. of bed area. The fertilizer should be kept away from the base of shrubs. Water in after application. For trees (including palm), apply 0.5 lbs. of fertilizer per inch of trunk diameter at chest height (4" diameter tree = 2.0 lbs. of fertilizer) evenly under the canopy of the tree. An alternate method is to auger holes 6 to 8 inches deep in a grid pattern. Keep holes at least 3 ft. from the base of the tree. Place fertilizer in holes, evenly applying the appropriate amount of fertilizer under the canopy of the tree using 0.5 lbs. per inch of trunk diameter at chest height (a 4" diameter tree would require a total of 2.0 lbs. of fertilizer). Then finish filling the holes with dirt. Using either method, no more than 8.0 lbs. of fertilizer per application should be used per 1,000 sq. ft. of ground area. Water in after application.
